Syllabus: Navi 1- Trei Asar

Goals:

- Students will develop a deep love of Torah as not only a subject but a guide for life, with ideas and role models that they can relate and aspire to.

- Students will sharpen their textual reading and translating skills by reading perakim aloud, breaking down words by shoresh (or 'root'), and learning new vocabulary.
- Students will build confidence in our discussion-based classroom model where they will be encouraged to share, question, comment, and present.
- Students will appreciate the books of Trei Asar (Twelve Prophets) as a glimpse into the greatness of each prophet and a study of how they worked to be the mouthpiece of Hashem for the Jewish people. Students will come away from each lesson with at least one practical application for their own lives.

Assignments:

- Assignments (reading text aloud and sending over their recording, completing worksheets, tests, quizzes, projects) will all be announced in class and posted on the Google classroom. Expect at least one assignment per week.
