Course Description:

English 10 Honors focuses on critical analysis of literature. Students will be expected to examine various aspects of literature to include structure, style, theme, symbolism and tone. Analysis of characters' values, assumptions, biases and human traits would lead to discussions about how each girl would have reacted under similar conditions, and thus examine their own set of beliefs and expectations.

English 10 Honors focuses on fiction from various time periods which opens the door to an examination of the historical and cultural backgrounds as depicted in the work at hand. All selections are pre approved by Mrs. Broudy and Rabbi Daniel Reich.

Class expectations are standard for 10th grade English Language Arts course. Students are required to complete the reading assignments and all activities within a set time frame. Written assignments would require a presentation of a thesis supported by clear arguments and quotations from the literary piece.

Students will be expected to keep all course materials in a 3-ring binder, and have it available at each session.
